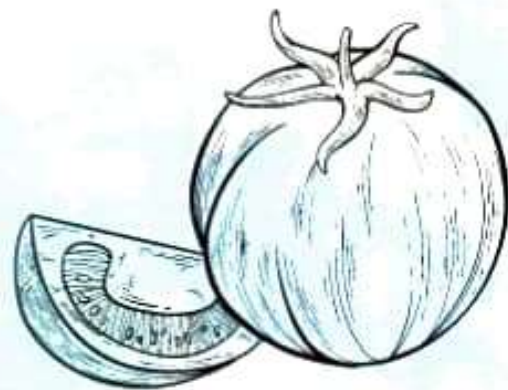


RULES AND REGULATIONS:
