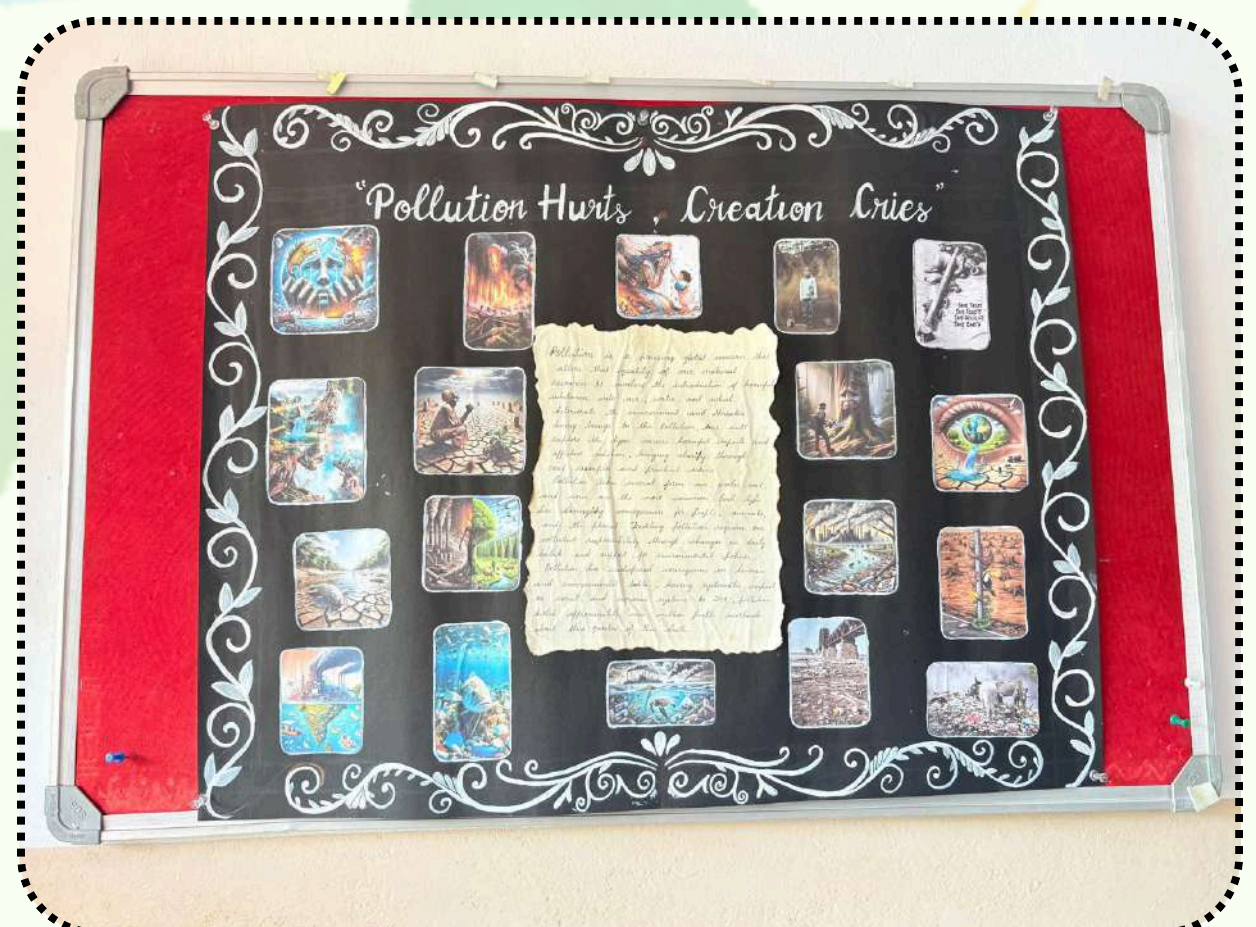
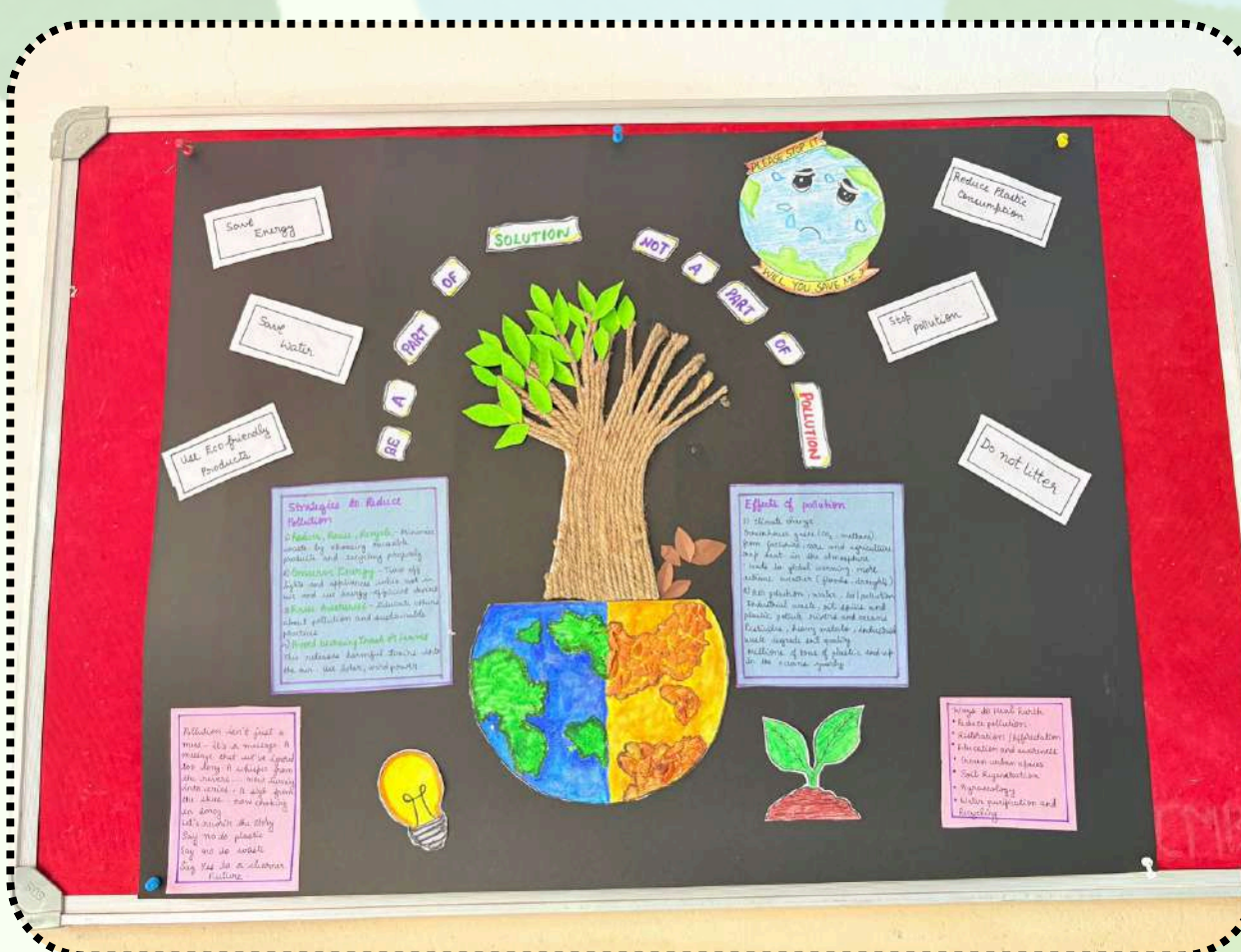
TRANSITIZIO
